Deployment automation guide



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Setup "template" configuration of the client

- 1. Preferably start with a clean database
 - Database is stored in %APPDATA%\eM Client
- 2. Set all the required settings & accounts
 - Note: in order to make sure that a 'Holidays have been found' notification isn't displayed, go to Calendar, wait until this notification is shown and then click 'No'
 - You may activate the client. The exported file will contain the activation code
- 3. Go to File > Export > Export settings to .xml file
- 4. Export settings and/or rule and/or accounts into an .xml file (named 'settings.xml' by default)

Customize the exported 'settings.xml'

- 1. To make an exported account blank, open the exported .xml file and:
 - a. Remove tag <AccountName> ... </ AccountName> The current Windows user name will be used
 - b. Remove tag <PersonName> ... </PersonName> The current Windows user name will be used
 - c. Remove tag <Addresses> ... </Addresses> Email address will be obtained from CalDAV server
 - d. Remove tag <LoginName> ... </LoginName> from each <Protocol> tag The user will fill the credentials upon eM Client execution

2. If the template configuration was not activated, **you can supply the activation code through the .xml file**. Add "<LastActivationKey>ACTIVATION_KEY_HERE</LastActivationKey>" into \<settings>\<general-settings> section of the .xml file

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Customize new eM Client installation

- 1. Preferably start with a new database
- 2. To import the customized settings.xml file AND to activate the client
 - Run MailClient.exe /importsettings -s C:\PATH_TO_XML_FILE\settings.xml /activate
- The client will import the settings, activate and exit without any user interface being shown 3. **Run the client**
 - Enter credentials dialog will be shown this is where the user enters his credentials.
 - Remember to check the Save Password checkbox to store the credentials permanently
